2023 TALLINN OPEN Training Camp "Adding something new to your style"

TALLINN OPEN INTERNATIONAL WRESTLING TRAINING CAMP: The TALLINN OPEN training camp is a unique high-level training opportunity which takes place immediately after the tournament (March 27 - 29, 2023) at the compe-tition site. The motto for the 2023 camp is "adding something new to your own style".

The 2022 Camp was attended by 330 GR, FS and FW wrestlers of Schoolboy/girl, Cadet and Junior age from 19-countries. With such a wide diversity of wrestlers, the camp emphasises sparring, to maximise experience from different schools of wrestling, to help you add to your "own wrestling style". This is a vetted camp (not for beginners) and the number of participants is limited.

Training and Coaching is led by various participating coaches, over 20 Trainers and Coaches from various countries participated.

Overview:

- Camp is March 27 29, 2023 on 14-mats at the Competition Site.
- Two sessions per day
- Saunas, showers, facilities available
- Cost of camp is 20 eur/day. This includes 2-training sessions, facilities and two meals.
- Free transportation is provided by the City of Tallinn during the competition and training

2023 TALLINN OPEN – KR. PALUSALU YOUTH WRESTLING TOURNAMENT

After two years of cancellations, the 2022 edition of TALLINN OPEN was again the largest European wrestling event. With RUS and BLR not being able to participate, the 2022 event was attended by 1496 GR, FS and WW wrestlers (including 272 women) from 29-countries.

Young wrestlers have the opportunity to duplicate this feat, by participating in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle days.

In 2019 – two wrestlers accomplished this endeavour!

The TALLINN OPEN organising committee, is pleased to invite you to Europe's largest wrestling tournament, the 2023 TALLINN OPEN – KRISTJAN PALUSALU YOUTH WRESTLING TOURNAMENT in GR, FS and FW, from 24 – 26 march, 2023. The tournament is on 14-mats and employs the Nordic A/B system, guaranteeing a two-match minimum. It is possible to wrestle in both GR and FS on subsequent days. TALLINN OPEN is for experienced wrestlers. and is limited to 2200 wrestlers.

The 2022 TALLINN OPEN was attended by 1496 wrestlers (including 272 women) from 29-countries. Many National Teams use Tallinn Open for preparation or as a benchmark qualification tournament for European and World Championships. The 2022 protocol is here: https://www.liga-db.de/TallinnOpen2022/

NOTE: In 2019, registration was closed 4-weeks before start of competition, since maximum number of participants was reached.

REFEREE:

Registered referees will be paid 100 eur for each complete day.

PARTICIPATION FEES:

Possibility to wrestle on both days.

- 25 euro Greco-Roman OR Freestyle. After 1-march participation is 30 eur.
- 35 euro Greco-Roman AND Freestyle. After 1-march participation is 40 eur. An additional fee of 5 eur/wrestler is charged to those teams without a referee.

Registered referees will be paid 100 eur for each complete day.
