TALLINN OPEN INTERNATIONAL WRESTLING TRAINING CAMP: The TALLINN OPEN training camp (March 31 – April 2, 2025) is a unique high-level training opportunity which takes place immediately following the tournament at the competition site. The motto for the 2025 camp is "adding something new to your own style".

The 2024 Camp was attended by 754 GR, FS and WW wrestlers of Schoolboy/girl, Cadet and Junior age from 30-countries. With such a wide diversity of wrestlers, the camp emphasises sparring, to maximise experience from different schools of wrestling, to help you add to your "own wrestling style". This is a vetted camp (not for beginners) and the number of participants is limited.

Training camp sessions are led by the various participating coaches. Every session is led by a coach of a different country. This is a popular and excellent opportunity for coaches and trainers to exchange ideas and gain experience from different schools of wrestling.

Overview:

- Camp is March 30 April 2, 2025 on 14-mats at the Competition Site
- Two sessions per day
- Saunas, showers, facilities available
- Cost of camp is 25 eur/day. This includes 2-training sessions, facilities and two meals
- Free transportation is provided by the City of Tallinn during the competition and training camp

KRISTJAN PALUSALU



Kristjan Palusalu is Estonia's most famous sports person, having won the Heavyweight Gold Medal at the 1936 Berlin Olympics in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle. Kristjan remains the only person to ever have achieved this feat at the same Olympic Games.

Young wrestlers have the opportunity to duplicate this feat, by participating in both Greco-Roman and Freestyle days.

The TALLINN OPEN organising committee, is please to invite you to Europe's largest wrestling tournament, the 2025 TALLINN OPEN – KRISTJAN PALUSALU YOUTH WRESTLING TOURNAMENT in GR, FS and WW, from 28–30 march, 2025. The tournament is on 14-mats and employs the Nordic A/B system which guarantees a two match miinimum. It is possible to wrestle both GR and FS on subsequent days. TALLINN OPEN is for experienced wrestlers and is limited to 2400 wrestlers.

The 2024 TALLINN OPEN was attended by 2335 wrestlers (including 416 women) from 38-countries. Many National Teams use Tallinn Open for preparation or as a benchmark qualification tournament for European (Continental) and World Championships. The 2024 tournament attracted over 40 national teams of various age-groups in GR, FS and FW. The 2024 protocol is here: www.liga-db.de/TallinnOpen2024

TALLINN OPEN is immediately followed by the International Wrestling Training Camp from March 31 – April 2, 2025. The 2024 training camp attracted 754 GR, FS and WW wrestlers from 30-countries (please see Training Camp on page 4).

NOTE: In 2024, registration was closed 4-weeks before start of competition, since maximum number of participants was reached.

REFEREE:

Experienced accredited referees are encouraged to participate. In 2024 there was 72 referees from 15-countries. Referees are provided accommodations and meals and compensated:

- 125eur per day for International Category referees
- 100eur per day for National Category referees

PARTICIPATION FEES:

Possibility to wrestle both GR and FS.

- 35 euro Greco-Roman OR Freestyle. After 1-march participation is 40 euro.
- 45 euro Greco-Roman AND Freestyle. After 1-march participation is 50 euro.
- 35 euro Woman's Wrestling. After 1-march participation is 40 euro.

An additional fee of 10 euro/wreslter is charged for those teams without a referee.

Over 300 teams from circa 40 countries are participating. To avoid onsite registration and payment delays – we strongly suggest pre-payment. We understand that there may be last-minute lineup changes and guarantee that any overpayment will be reimbursed. Thank-you.
